LINDHOLME MOTOR SPORTS CLUB CLASSIC TOUR: Sun 7 May 2023 FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Many thanks for your entry on the 2023 Tour. **The Motorsport UK Event Permit/Certificate of Exemption is Number 129855**. Please see the attached Entry List/Running Order for your start number. Car 1 will start at 10.31, with the rest at one minute intervals. You will be able to work out your own start time from this.

Crews should arrive at the Start from 08.45am onwards, and no later than one hour before their due start time. **Start: Cusworth Hall, Doncaster Post Code DN5 7TU** Map ref. **111/554040** From A1M J 37, take A635 towards Doncaster Town Centre, then follow the Cusworth Hall brown signs.

Show the gate marshal your event pass: a copy of the Tour Plate, sent by email. This may be on paper, or on your phone. Follow the LMSC arrows and directions of marshals to park your car. If the driver and navigator are arriving separately, you may leave a car at Cusworth whilst you do the tour. Ask a marshal on site for the parking location. Let Len have the registration number of the car being left: this will avoid having to pay the full day parking fee!

Find Len's white Subaru Forester to "sign on" and collect your **Road Book pack**. This contains your **Tour Plate**, to be affixed at the front of the car, as upright as you can – it shows up better in the photos! Long cable ties will be provided for fixing. It's a good idea to bring some scissors to cut the spare ends of the cable ties. Alternatively, bring some plastic tape as a fixing method for the plate. We will supply a small Union Flag to decorate your car if you so choose.

The pack also contains your vouchers for refreshments at the Finish, and two pens.

Breakfast items will be on sale at the **Courtyard Cafe**: go towards the Hall, and look for the serving hatch.

Event Schedule:

These timings are based on an average speed of approx. 20 mph. However, you will have plenty of time to stop and admire the view, take a photo, or spot the observation answers – this is not a race or rally!

- 08.45 Start parking area opens
- 09.00 Signing on and Road Book collection begins. Breakfast service.
- 10.31 First car leaves Cusworth Hall. Zero your trip meter at the exit gate
- 14.00 First car due at Finish Refreshments available – included in the entry fee

The total route is approx 80 miles, mainly on quiet country roads. The **Roadbook** will give you all the route directions, in an easy to follow format. If you are not familiar with **"Tulip" diagrams**, we can offer further help if you contact us. Essentially, they are just little diagrams of road junctions, which show you which way to turn, with distances between them. As you drive along, "carry straight on" junctions are mostly ignored, although we have put a few in for greater clarity. Total and interval mileages are given. Occasionally, an LMSC orange arrow may aid your route finding: some junctions have no signs there at all!

At the top of each page the WHAT 3 WORDS reference for the 1st tulip on the page is shown. This can reveal exactly where you are in case you get lost! WHAT 3 WORDS can be downloaded from your app store.

Tourist notes are included, to point out features of interest. If you want to have a go at the **observation quiz**, the answers may be written into the road book. Bring it to Ian & Gwen or Len & Jan for checking answers, or use one of the Answer copies which will be around at the Finish.

The Running Order list is mostly based on the order of receipt of entries, adapted for those who want to run in proximity to the cars of friends. **Please do not travel the route in long convoys: 2 or 3 cars are enough.**

As you drive along, please be mindful of other road users, such as farm vehicles, cyclists, horse riders and pedestrians. If you are looking for a quiz answer, don't obstruct other vehicles. We have included some safety notes at a few points of the route, and please take extra care with all right turns. If you have any car-related problems, please phone Len or Ian on the mobile numbers shown below. Len will not be following the route; Ian and Gwen will be in the Course Opening car.

There is no Midway Halt, but the road book lists a point to stop if you need it: see after Tulip 53 – Leger Lakes Tearoom. No "bookings" have been made there. There is a filling station shown on Tulip 59 (at 59 miles).

Finish: Cusworth Hall. Go into the car park area used at the Start.

Tea/coffee and a cake or sconewill be served inside the Hall or in the central entrance area if the weather is fine. It's included within your entry fee.
