






Lindholme Classic Tour 7 May 2023**

This event is a Touring Assembly, not a race or a rally. We hope you will enjoy a steady drive through attractive South Yorkshire and North Nottinghamshire countryside. You will have ample time to stop to admire a view or look for Quiz answers. The Tourist Notes may provide some extra points of interest.

Some of the sections of the route may be busy with local traffic or farm vehicles. Therefore, when driving, or stopping, we ask that you respect other road users (especially cyclists) and residents of the villages you pass through. Here is an example of how "Tulip" route instructions work. This one is not on today's route.

The first column shows the tulip number.

The second column shows the distance of the junction from the start of the event: in the example above 2.15 miles. The third column shows the distance from the previous junction: in this example, 0.74 miles. All these mileages are taking using the **Tripmeter** app which is available in the app store.

The "tulip" in the fourth column is a small diagram of the junction. You approach the junction from the dot and depart in the direction of the arrow: in this example, you will turn right at a crossroads. Additional information or advice may appear with the tulip - e.g. Give Way at this junction. Also some locations and postcodes are shown to help you round the route. Not all junctions are included, so if there is no tulip, you should stay on the road you are on.

The fifth column gives further information, such as a direction or road name: in this example there is a direction sign pointing towards Anywhere and a road nameplate "Abbey Road". There may also be advice about road conditions. Please note that some junctions do not have any direction signs or street names, so the Information box will be blank.

At the top of each page the WHAT 3 WORDS reference for the 1st tulip on the page is shown. WHAT 3 WORDS can be downloaded from your apps store.

We have included an optional observation quiz, just for a bit of fun - there are no prizes. Most answers can be spotted as you drive; a few may require you to slow down or stop. A checklist of answers will be available at the finish.
